HIV Tests - 2012

- ❖ Funded agencies - Federal and/or State – Approximately 35
- ❖ Non - funded agencies – Approximately 140

- ❖ Total HIV tests performed-All Sites–98,502
- ❖ Total HIV tests performed-Funded sites–62,149 (63.1%)
- ❖ Total HIV tests performed Non-Funded sites–36,353 (36.9%)

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Seropositivity Rate - 2012

- ❖ Total HIV positive test at All Sites – 584
- ❖ Overall Seropositivity Rate – 0.6 %
(Six Positive Per 1000 Tests)

- ❖ Total HIV positive tests at Funded Sites – 449
- ❖ Overall Seropositivity Rate – 0.72%
(Seven Positive Per 1000 Tests)

- ❖ Total HIV positive tests at Non-Funded Sites - 135
- ❖ Overall Seropositivity Rate – 0.37%
(Between Three and Four Positive Per 1000 Tests)

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Data Analysis – HIV Positive Referrals - 2012

- ❖ 81.7% were referred to medical services
- ❖ 45% were referred to prevention services
